Pleasanton High School is looking forward to welcoming you to our school. I hope all of you will have a great contest. I know you are aware that we will still be in class, and if you will remind your students, I would be very grateful. Here is some information you will need about the contest and a map to help you navigate the campus. Please remember to turn in your Form 1, scores, and Contest Announcement and Band Set-up sheet to the Contest Office before you begin your warm-up.

BUS INFORMATION

To enter our campus, please follow the map enclosed. This is the easiest way for buses to enter and exit the facility. The buses will park in our stadium parking lot. We have secured half of the parking lot for buses. (We do not have dressing facilities.) Please remind your students not to leave valuables or money on the bus, or arrange for someone to monitor your buses while you are participating in the contest.

EQUIPMENT TRUCKS/ TRAILERS

You may unload equipment at the loading dock. After unloading, equipment trailers or trucks will then need to be moved to the parking area.

WARM UP

Warm up will be in our choir room. We will have a Peterson 13-window tuner and metronome in this room. If you need anything else, just let us know.

STAGE DIMENSIONS

Back Curtain to Apron: 28'
Width: 45'

AVAILABLE EQUIPMENT

Large percussion equipment on stage will be Concert Bass Drum, Chimes, Xylophone, Concert Bells, Vibraphone, 4.3 octave Marimba and a set of 4 timpani. You are welcome to bring any equipment you would like to use. There is a loading dock on the side of the stage. We will have a crew to help set the stage and move equipment.

SIGHT-READING

Sight-reading will be in the Band Hall. We have included the information on what percussion equipment will be needed. We will try to supply as much as we can.

COMMENT SHEETS

Directors may pick up Awards and comment sheets in the Contest Office next to the band hall.

CONTEST OFFICE

The Contest Office will be located in the large ensemble room next to the band hall. See us in the contest office when you arrive.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Auditorium doors will be closed during performances. Please do not try to enter while someone is performing. Once inside, please follow standard rules of auditorium etiquette. No food, drinks, gum or other items are allowed in the auditorium.

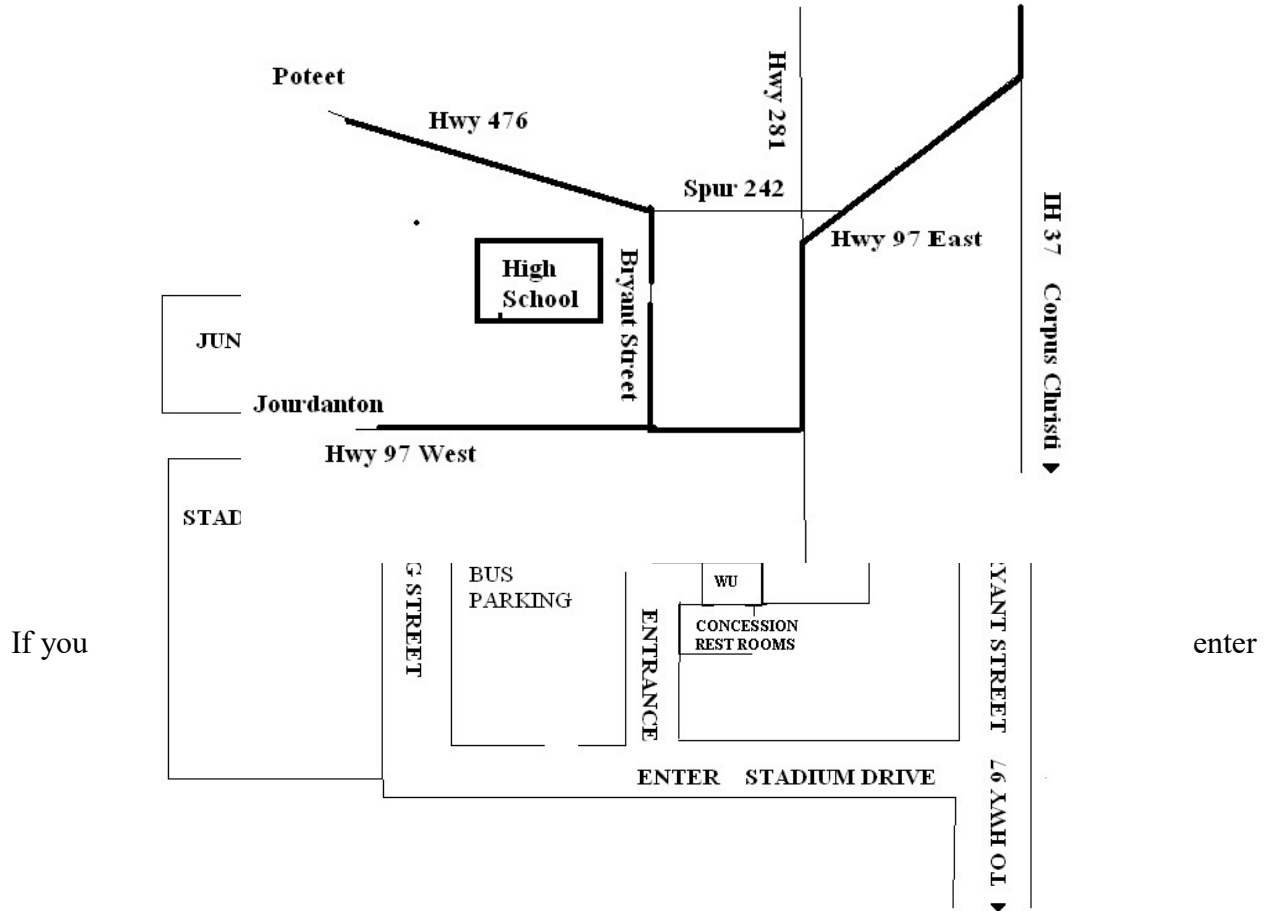

Pleasanton from IH37 Southbound, take the Hwy 97 and turn left. Follow 97 to Bryant Street. Turn right on Bryant and go to Stadium Drive.

If you enter Pleasanton on Hwy 97 coming through Jourdanton, turn left on Bryant Street and go to Stadium Drive.

If you enter Pleasanton from Poteet, follow Hwy 242 until you get to Bryant. Turn Right on Bryant until you come to Stadium Drive.
