Middle School and High School Orchestra Directors,

I am looking forward to hosting the UIL Concert and Sight-Reading Evaluation on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, and Wednesday, March 4, 2026.

Things to consider:

- Directors will need to wear their staff ID's anywhere on SCUCISD property and they will need to verify entrance for their participating students. Students wearing uniforms and having instruments in hand will establish entrance for these participating students. Participating students need to be accompanied by a director or chaperone when moving around the campus.
- All parents, guests, and chaperones attending the contest, will need to report in at the Clemens front office to receive a visitor's sticker and parking pass to park near the auditorium entrance.
- All entering schools and guests, when entering the parking lot for the campus you will be greeted by a security guard. You will need to have the parking flyer displayed in the windshield of your car or ready to show the security guard upon entering the parking lot.
- Parking is very limited on our campuses during the school day.

Bus Information and Contest Rooms and Locations (See map for additional help with bus drop off and parking area):

- Buses will enter the front side of Clemens HS (Elbel Road side) through the entrance beside the stadium.
- Buses will drop directors and students off at the rear entrance to the Event Center (there is a road that circles around small building) and then buses will need to park in the campus parking area behind the football field/stadium.
- Directors should check in at the contest office upon arriving, located in the Fine Arts Building ensemble room (F114).
- Students will unpack in the small rehearsal hall (F102), located in the Fine Arts Building.
- Students will warm-up in the black box (Q107), located in the Event Center.
- Students will sight-read in the orchestra room (F103), located in the Fine Arts Building.

***Don't forget to get the contact information for your bus driver, so you can call them when your school is ready to load the bus after the contest.

***Please note that school is in session on these days and it would be best that when schools are finished competing they make plans to return to their campus, this will help reduce traffic congestion on the campus.

*****Please note that visiting schools are not permitted to eat lunch at the Clemens campus. Directors of visiting campuses should coordinate a location outside of Clemens to eat lunch with their students or on their school buses.**

Things that we will provide:

- Chairs and music stands.
- Large podium in the sight reading room and auditorium.
- Small podium in the warm-up room.
- McAdams metronome/tuner in the warm-up and sight reading room.

Things to remember:

- There are classes on the days of the contest, please remind students to be quiet in the hallways and building.
- Don't forget to bring any extra string instrument supplies that you may need.
- All cello and bass students will need to use a rock-stop during the warm-up, concert performance, and sight reading, so we don't damage the floors.

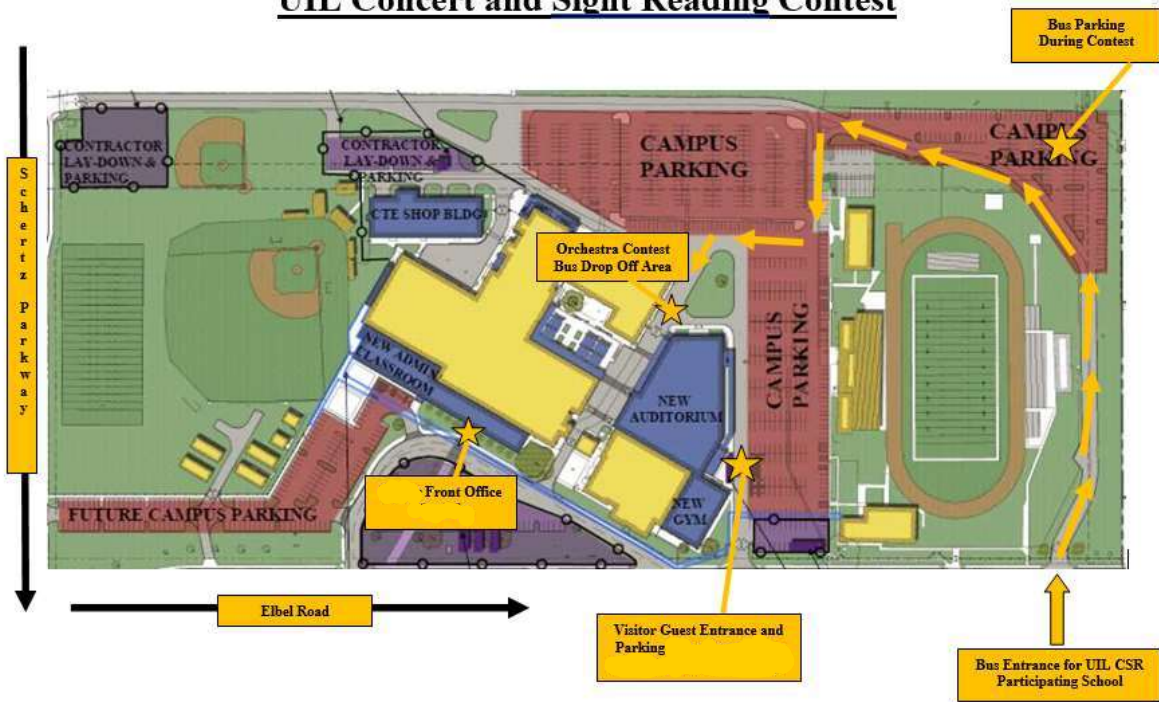
Directions:

- Option A (if coming from the San Antonio area): Take I-35 N, exit Schertz Parkway and take a right, stay on Schertz Parkway for about 4 miles and take a left onto Elbel Road.
- Option B (if coming from the San Antonio area): Take I-35 N, exit Roy Richards Drive (FM 3009) and take a right, stay on Roy Richards Drive (FM 3009) for about 5 miles and take a right onto Elbel Road.
